MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of Syndel T. appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Portland, *Bradley, J.*) terminating her parental rights pursuant to 22 M.R.S.A. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (1992). Contrary to the mother's contentions, no violation of her due process rights occurred, *see In re Alexander D.*, 1998 ME 207, ¶ 13, 716 A.2d 222, 226, and the record supports the court's finding by clear and convincing evidence of at least one ground of parental unfitness, *see In re Alana S.*, 2002 ME 126, ¶ 20, 802 A.2d 976, 981, and that termination of parental rights is in Syndel's best interest, *see In re Jeremiah Y.*, 2002 ME 135, ¶ 9, 804 A.2d 357, 359.
