MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Dana I. Haven appeals from an order entered in the Superior Court, (Penobscot County, *Mead, J.*) dismissing his complaint concerning actions of Judge Worth in her official capacity. Because government employees acting in a judicial capacity are absolutely immune from civil suit pursuant to 14 M.R.S.A. § 8111(1)(B) (2003), Haven has not stated a claim upon which relief can be granted. Therefore, the Superior Court did not err in dismissing Haven's suit.
