MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Kevin Kelly appeals from a divorce judgment entered in the District Court (Rockland, *Anderson, J.*). Contrary to his contentions, the trial court did not exceed the bounds of its discretion in dividing the marital property, *see Kapler v. Kapler*, 2000 ME 131, ¶ 8, 755 A.2d 502, 506, nor did the trial court violate any positive rule of law by failing to consider the duration of the marriage, *see Arey v. Arey*, 651 A.2d 351, 353 (Me. 1994) (“When dividing the marital property, the court must consider the factors set forth . . . [by statute] and may, within its discretion, consider all factors relevant to a particular divorce.”).
