MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Cynthia and William Tompson appeal from a judgment in the District Court (Lewiston, *Lawrence, J.*) in favor of their daughter, Elizabeth Tompson. Contrary to Cynthia and William's contention, the court did not err in determining that they lacked standing to litigate their claim for visitation pursuant to the Grandparents Visitation Act, 19-A M.R.S.A. §§ 1801-1805 (1998 & Supp. 2003). *See Robichaud v. Pariseau*, 2003 ME 54, ¶¶ 8-10, 820 A.2d 1212, 1215-16.
