MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Robert Holland-Stanley appeals from a judgment of conviction entered in the Superior Court (Lincoln County, *Studstrup, J.*) after a jury found him guilty of making a false public report (Class D) pursuant to 17-A M.R.S.A. § 509(1)(A) (1983). Contrary to Holland-Stanley's assertions, the court did not err by admitting into evidence a written statement that Holland-Stanley delivered to a police officer, *see State v. Poirier*, 1997 ME 86, ¶ 4, 694 A.2d 448, 449, nor did the court abuse its discretion by declining to dismiss the case or strike a police

officer's testimony following allegations that the officer committed perjury, *see State v. DePhilippo*, 628 A.2d 1057, 1058 (Me. 1993); *Freeman v. Funtown/Splashtown, USA*, 2003 ME 101, ¶ 7, 828 A.2d 752, 754. Finally, viewing the evidence in the light most favorable to the State, the jury "could have found beyond a reasonable doubt every element of the offense charged." *State v. McCurdy*, 2002 ME 66, ¶ 10, 795 A.2d 84, 88 (internal quotations omitted).
