MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of Kyle C., Conner C., and Jason C., appeals from the judgment of the District Court (Ellsworth, *Staples, J.*) terminating her parental rights pursuant to 22 M.R.S.A. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (2004). Contrary to the mother's contentions, the evidence in the record fully supports the District Court's conclusions, by clear and convincing evidence, that the mother was unwilling or unable to protect the children from jeopardy, those circumstances were unlikely to change within a time reasonably calculated to meet the children's needs and termination of parental rights was in the children's best interests. *See In re Heather G.*, 2002 ME 151, ¶ 12, 805 A.2d 249, 252; *In re Charles G.*, 2001 ME 3, ¶ 5, 763 A.2d 1163, 1166.
