#### MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Noreen-Evelyn Strout appeals from orders of the District Court (South Paris, *McElwee, J.*) denying her motion to request justice; her motion to waive the twenty-one day response period and expedited hearing; dismissing her motion for contempt; and denying her application for waiver of the costs of filing an appeal. Contrary to the Noreen's assertions, the court did not err in denying her motions for a specific judge or for an expedited hearing, *see* M.R. Civ. P. 7(b)(7), nor did the court err in dismissing her motion for contempt pursuant to Rule 12(b)(6), *see In re Wage Payment Litig.*, 2000 ME 162, ¶ 3, 759 A.2d 217, 220. Finally, the

court did not err in denying her application for a waiver of filing fees and court costs. *See* M.R. Civ. P. 91(b).
