MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother and father of Calvin N. and Austin N. appeal from a judgment of the District Court (West Bath, *Field, J.*) terminating their parental rights pursuant to 22 M.R.S.A. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (2004). Contrary to their contentions, the court did engage in a critical analysis of the evidence presented by the parties, *see In re Marpheen C.*, 2002 ME 170, ¶¶ 7-8, 812 A.2d 972, 974, and the record supports the court's finding by clear and convincing evidence of at least one ground of parental unfitness, *see In re Alana S.*, 2002 ME 126, ¶ 20, 802 A.2d 976, 981, and that termination of parental rights is in Calvin and Austin's best interests, *see In re Jeremiah Y.*, 2002 ME 135, ¶ 9, 804 A.2d 357, 359.
