### MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Michelle Bourget appeals, on behalf of Scott Bourget, the final protection order entered by the District Court (Biddeford, *Foster, J.*). Because the hearing was not recorded, Bourget's attorney served an affidavit in lieu of a transcript, pursuant to M.R. Civ. P. 74(c).<sup>1</sup> However, the record does not indicate that the affidavit was filed with the District Court so it could be "settled and approved," as required by M.R. Civ. P. 74(c). Without a record of the proceedings, "we must assume that there was sufficient evidence to support the court's factual findings." *Alley v. Alley*, 2002 ME 162, ¶ 2, 809 A.2d 1262, 1262.
