MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Sharon R. Coffin appeals from a judgment entered after a hearing in District Court (South Paris, *McElwee, J.*) in favor of her ex-husband, Fred W. Coffin Jr. Contrary to Sharon's contention, the court did not abuse its discretion in granting Fred's motion for relief pursuant to M.R. Civ. P. 60(b) in order to allow Fred to move for a change in spousal support upon Sharon's cohabitation or remarriage or a change in his financial situation. *See Ketchum v. Ketchum*, 2000 ME 13, ¶ 7, 743 A.2d 1270, 1272. Because Sharon has not provided us with a transcript of the hearing or a statement of the evidence pursuant to M.R. App. P. 5(d), "we must

assume that the record fully supports the findings and discretionary choices made by the” trial court as a result of the hearing. *Rothstein v. Maloney*, 2002 ME 179, ¶ 11, 816 A.2d 812, 813.
