MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of Keegan, Quinten, and Lexis G. appeals from the judgment of the District Court (Newport, *MacMichael*, *J*.) terminating her parental rights pursuant to 22 M.R.S.A. § 4055 (2004). Contrary to the mother's contentions, the procedure followed by the court when terminating her parental rights was tailored to protect her constitutional rights and to preserve the government's interests in stabilizing the children without undue delay and in avoiding security risks. *See In re Randy Scott B.*, 511 A.2d 450, 452-53 (Me. 1986).
