MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Lyman Pope appeals from a judgment entered in the District Court (Biddeford, *Janelle, J.*) terminating a temporary order for protection from harassment and declining to issue a permanent protection from harassment order against Alfred Hubacz, pursuant to 5 M.R.S.A. §§ 4651-4660(a) (2002). Contrary to Pope's contention, the court did not exceed the bounds of its discretion by failing to issue the protection order. Section 4655 endows trial courts with broad discretion in determining whether relief is appropriate and what form it should take. *See* 5 M.R.S.A. § 4655 (A)-(F) (2002).
