MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of Nikita S. and Tye D.S. appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Calais, *Romei, J.*) terminating her parental rights with respect to both children pursuant to 22 M.R.S.A. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (2004). Contrary to the mother's contentions, the record supports by clear and convincing evidence the District Court's findings that at least one ground of parental unfitness exists, *see, e.g., In re Alana S.*, 2002 ME 126, ¶ 20, 802 A.2d 976, 981, and that termination of parental rights is in the children's best interests, *see, e.g., In re Jeremiah Y.*, 2002 ME 135, ¶ 9, 804 A.2d 357, 359.
