#### MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of Celina M. appeals from a judgment entered in the District Court (Waterville, *Vafiades, C.J.*) terminating her parental rights pursuant to 22 M.R.S.A. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (2004). Contrary to the mother's contentions, the record supports the court's finding, by clear and convincing evidence, of parental unfitness, and that termination of the mother's parental rights is in Celina's best interests. *See In re Jeremiah Y.*, 2002 ME 135, ¶ 9, 804 A.2d 357, 359.
