MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Douglas Flewelling appeals from a judgment entered in the District Court (Augusta, *Westcott, J.*) granting Tammy Flewelling's motion for modification of the parties' divorce judgment. Contrary to Douglas's contention, the court did not clearly err in finding a substantial change in circumstances since the previous order justifying a modification of the allocation of parental rights regarding the education of the parties' minor child. *See Ehrlich v. Bloom*, 585 A.2d 809, 812 (Me. 1991) (holding that a finding of changed circumstances will be vacated only if the court clearly erred).
