MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

James J. Wardach appeals from a divorce judgment entered in the District Court (West Bath, *Field, J.*). By Wardach's failure to appear in court, he did not preserve the issues on appeal. *See Gilmore v. Cent. Me. Power Co.*, 665 A.2d 666, 669 (Me. 1995). Contrary to his contentions, the court did not commit obvious error, or act beyond its discretion, in awarding retroactive child support, distributing retirement funds and stocks, awarding spousal support, ordering Wardach to pay attorney fees, or finding that the parties had divided their personal property. *See id.*; *see also Tibbetts v. Tibbetts*, 2000 ME 210, ¶ 6, 762 A.2d 937, 939.
