### MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Audrey Belisle appeals from a judgment of conviction entered in the District Court (Bangor, *Gunther*, *J.*) following a jury-waived trial for illegally passing a stopped school bus (Class E), 29-A M.R.S.A. § 2308(2) (1996 & Supp. 2004). Contrary to Belisle's contentions, the evidence, when viewed in the light most favorable to the State, was sufficient for a fact-finder to rationally find each element of the offense beyond a reasonable doubt. *See State v. Gorman*, 2004 ME 90, ¶ 56, 854 A.2d 1164, 1178, *cert. denied*, --- U.S. --- (2005).
