MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother and father of Amber H. appeal from judgments of the District Court (Newport, *MacMichael, J.*) terminating their parental rights pursuant to 22 M.R.S.A. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (2004). Contrary to the mother's contentions, sufficient evidence exists in the record to support the court's finding by clear and convincing evidence of at least one ground of parental unfitness, *see In re Alana S.*, 2002 ME 126, ¶ 20, 802 A.2d 976, 981, and, contrary to the contentions of both the mother and the father, there is sufficient evidence in the record to support the court's finding by clear and convincing evidence that termination of both appellants' parental rights is in the child's best interest, *see* 22 M.R.S.A. § 4055(1)(B)(2); *In re Jeremiah Y.*, 2002 ME 135, ¶ 9, 804 A.2d 357, 359; *In re Ryan L.*, 581 A.2d 811, 812 (Me. 1990).
