MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Terrence Sturtevant appeals from a judgment entered in the Superior Court (Franklin County, *Jabar*, *J*.) awarding compensatory and punitive damages to Teresa Sturtevant on her claims of assault and battery, intentional infliction of emotional distress, and negligent infliction of emotional distress. Terrence asserts that the evidence on the record is insufficient to support the finding that his actions caused injury to Teresa or to support the award of punitive damages. The record contains competent evidence to support both the trial court's findings that Terrence's conduct resulted in damages to Teresa, and that, by clear and convincing evidence, Terrence's conduct was motivated by ill will or was so

outrageous that malice can be implied. *See Palleschi v. Palleschi*, 1998 ME 3, ¶¶ 2, 6, 704 A.2d 383, 385-86.
