MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Darren M. Tripp appeals from a judgment of the Superior Court (Oxford County, *Delahanty, J.*) denying Tripp's motion for a trial of the facts and affirming the decision of the Town of Bethel's Board of Selectmen to affirm the town manager's termination of Tripp's employment as chief of police. Contrary to Tripp's contentions, the Board did not deprive him of procedural due process, *see Moen v. Town of Fairfield*, 1998 ME 135, ¶ 9, 713 A.2d 321, 324-25; *Cleveland Bd. of Educ. v. Loudermill*, 470 U.S. 532, 542-47 (1985), and did not err in denying his motion for a trial of the facts, M.R. Civ. P. 80B(d); *Baker's Table, Inc.*

*v. City of Portland*, 2000 ME 7, ¶ 9, 743 A.2d 237, 240-41; *Ryan v. Town of Camden*, 582 A.2d 973, 975 (Me. 1990).
