MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

William C. Pacher appeals from a divorce judgment and subsequent orders entered in the District Court (Farmington, *Mullen, D.C.J.*) awarding Sharon M. (Pacher) Desruisseaux property in Chesterville and \$5491 in attorney fees and William \$5491 for his equitable interest in the property. We find that the court's characterization of the property as "mostly nonmarital" with a "very modest marital component" was not clearly erroneous, *Warren v. Warren*, 2005 ME 9, \$20, 866 A.2d 97, 101, *see* 19-A M.R.S.A. § 953 (1998 & Supp. 2005), and the

attorney fees award constituted a sustainable exercise of discretion, *Bartlett v. Anderson*, 2005 ME 10, \P 21, 866 A.2d 829, 834.
