MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Irene Plant appeals from a judgment entered in the Superior Court (Lincoln County, *Marden, J.*) on her adverse possession and acquiescence claims against F. Jason Morris and Winona Jenny Barry-Morris. Contrary to Plant's contentions, the evidence of missing monuments did not compel a contrary finding as to the boundary's location on the face of the earth, *see Wallingford v. Kennedy*, 2000 ME 112, ¶ 15, 753 A.2d 493, 497, and the record supports the court's conclusion that the adjoining landowners and their predecessors shared some of the disputed

property, see Striefel v. Charles-Keyt-Leaman P'ship, 1999 ME 111, ¶ 17, 733

A.2d 984, 993.
