MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

George A. Nedder appeals from a judgment entered in the District Court (York, *Wheeler, J.*), finding that he had committed a speeding infraction in violation of 29-A M.R.S.A. § 2073(3) (1996). Contrary to Nedder's contentions, the court did not clearly err in assessing the credibility of testimony at trial, *see State v. McCurdy*, 2002 ME 66, ¶ 10, 795 A.2d 84, 88; *In re Amberley D.*, 2001 ME 87, ¶ 21, 775 A.2d 1158, 1165, sufficient evidence exists in the record to support the court's judgment, *see* M.R. Civ. P. 80F(h); *City of Bangor v. Diva's, Inc.*, 2003 ME 51, ¶ 7, 830 A.2d 898, 901, and the State did not violate its discovery obligations, *see* M.R. Civ. P. 80F(f).
