MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Keerstin Harrington appeals a judgment entered in the District Court (Waterville, *Perry, A.R.J.*), denying her request for a protection from harassment order against Lee Herbert, Debra Herbert, and April Cusson pursuant to 5 M.R.S.A. § 4655 (2002 & Supp. 2004). The court found that Harrington did not prove that the defendants engaged in acts of harassment as defined in 5 M.R.S.A. § 4651 (2002 & Supp. 2004). In the absence of a transcript, we assume that the court's findings are supported by the record. *Alley v. Alley*, 2002 ME 162, ¶¶ 1, 2, 809 A.2d 1262, 1262.
