MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Perry A. Lamb appeals from a judgment entered in the Superior Court (Franklin County, *Jabar*, *J*.) dismissing his appeal taken pursuant to 23 M.R.S.A. § 3029 (1992). Contrary to Lamb's contentions, the court correctly determined that it could not exercise its authority because the appeal was untimely filed, *see City of Lewiston v. Me. State Employees Ass'n*, 638 A.2d 739, 741 (Me. 1994), and the underlying incident in Lamb's complaint was fully adjudicated in *Lamb v. Town of Farmington*, 2004 ME 50, 846 A.2d 333.
