MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Clifford Mitchell appeals from a conviction for assault (Class C) in violation of 17-A M.R.S.A. § 207(1) (Supp. 2004) entered in the Superior Court (Washington County, *Jabar, J.*) following a jury trial. Contrary to Mitchell's contention that there was insufficient evidence for the jury to find that he caused offensive physical contact to another person, the jury rationally could have found, beyond a reasonable doubt, every element of the offense charged. *See State v. Black*, 2000 ME 211, ¶¶ 17-18, 763 A.2d 109, 113-14.
