MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

David Warrington appeals from an order entered in the District Court (Dover-Foxcroft, *Stitham, J.*) denying his motion to modify the visitation schedule with respect to his daughter. Contrary to Warrington's claims, the trial court acted within the scope of its discretion by declining to modify the schedule to include overnight visits, and by requiring that pick-ups and drop-offs for visitation occur in Belfast. *See Rodrigue v. Brewer*, 667 A.2d 605, 606 (Me. 1995).
