MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

David A. Labrecque appeals from a judgment entered in District Court (Augusta, *French, J.*) granting Anne A. Zayac sole parental rights and responsibilities and primary physical residence of their daughter and denying Labrecque any visitation rights but requiring him to pay support. As no transcript was provided, we must assume that the record fully supports the findings and discretionary choices made by the District Court. *Rothstein v. Maloney*, 2002 ME 179, ¶ 11, 816 A.2d 812, 813-14. Thus, we cannot find that the District Court erred in denying Labrecque visitation rights, *see In re Thomas H.*, 2005 ME 123,

¶ 16, 889 A.2d 297, 301, or in requiring Labrecque to pay support for his daughter, although he was denied visitation rights. *See* 19-A M.R.S. § 1504 (2005); *see also Dep't of Human Servs. v. Hafford*, 2003 ME 15, ¶ 13, 815 A.2d 806, 811 (“[U]nder Maine law, all parents have a general duty to support their children.”).
