MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Marek A. Kwasnik appeals from a judgment entered in the Superior Court (Cumberland County, *Cole, J.*) affirming a decision of the Unemployment Insurance Commission that Kwasnik had been discharged due to misconduct within the meaning of 26 M.R.S. § 1043(23) (2005). The Commission's factual finding is supported by competent evidence in the record and its application of the law to that finding was correct. *See Schwartz v. Unemployment Ins. Comm'n*, 2006 ME 41, ¶ 8, 895 A.2d 965, 969-70 (setting forth the relevant standard of review); 26 M.R.S. § 1043(23) (defining misconduct); 26 M.R.S. § 1221(3)(A)(1)

(2005) (providing that benefits may not be charged to an individual employer if the claimant's separation was due to misconduct).
