MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Paul F. Stevenson appeals from a judgment of conviction for criminal trespass (Class E), 17-A M.R.S. § 402(1)(E) (2005), entered after a nonjury trial in the District Court (Bangor, *A. Murray, D.C.J.*). Contrary to Stevenson's contentions, the court did not deny him the right to present a closing argument, *see* M.R. Crim. P. 30(a); *State v. Gilman*, 489 A.2d 1100, 1102-03 (Me. 1985), and sufficient evidence was presented at trial to support his conviction, *see State v. Turner*, 2001 ME 44, ¶ 6, 766 A.2d 1025, 1027.
