MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Richard Castonguay appeals from a divorce judgment entered in the District Court (Augusta, *French*, *J*.) following a trial. Although he alleges multiple factual errors in the court's classification and valuation of property, he made no request for further findings or motion to reconsider, and, on the record presented, the court's findings were not clearly erroneous. *See Bonville v. Bonville*, 2006 ME 3, ¶¶ 9, 13, 890 A.2d 263, 266-67. With respect to Castonguay's asserted evidentiary errors, the errors, if any, were harmless. *See* M.R. Civ. P. 61; M.R. Evid. 103; *In re Scott S.*, 2001 ME 114, ¶¶ 24-25, 775 A.2d 1144, 1152.
