MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Shawn P. Poliquin appeals the entry of a judgment of conviction by the Superior Court (Hancock County, *Mead, J.*) following a jury verdict of guilty for unlawful trafficking in scheduled drugs (Class B), 17-A M.R.S. § 1103(1-A)(A) (2005), and unlawful possession of a scheduled drug (Class D), 17-A M.R.S. § 1107-A(1)(C) (2005). Contrary to Poliquin's assertions, the court did not abuse its discretion when it admitted recordings of two alleged drug transactions, *see* M.R. Evid. 401, 403; *State v. Kalex*, 2002 ME 26, ¶ 10, 789 A.2d 1286, 1289, or commit clear error when it found that the proper foundation was laid and admitted drugs allegedly found at the scene of Poliquin's arrest, *see State v. Lobo*, 1998

ME 228, ¶ 10, 719 A.2d 108, 110; and the evidence was sufficient to support the conviction, *see State v. Michaud*, 1998 ME 251, ¶ 11, 724 A.2d 1222, 1228.
