MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Susan J. Greenlaw appeals from a judgment of conviction entered in the District Court (Ellsworth, *Murray, R., J.*) for assault (Class D), 17-A M.R.S. § 207(1)(A) (2005) following a jury-waived trial. Greenlaw asserts no specific contentions of error committed by the court, and a review of the record indicates no obvious error affecting Greenlaw's substantial rights. *See* M.R. Crim. P. 52(b). Further, viewing the evidence in the light most favorable to the State, sufficient record evidence exists to support the court's finding, beyond a reasonable doubt, that Greenlaw committed each element of assault. *See* 17-A M.R.S. § 207(1)(A); *State v. Bouchard*, 2005 ME 106, ¶ 10, 881 A.2d 1130, 1134.
