MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of Dillon V. appeals from a judgment of the District Court (Lewiston, *Lawrence, J.*) terminating her parental rights pursuant to 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (2005). Contrary to the mother's contentions, the record supports the court's findings by clear and convincing evidence of at least one ground of parental unfitness and that termination of parental rights is in the child's best interest. *See In re Thomas D.*, 2004 ME 104, ¶¶ 21, 38, 854 A.2d 195, 201, 207.
