MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Timothy Ames appeals from a judgment entered in the Superior Court (Penobscot County, *Mead, J.*) granting Joseph G.S. Robinson Jr.'s motion for a summary judgment and awarding damages in the amount of \$32,405 plus costs. Contrary to Ames's contention that the damages award was not supported by competent evidence, the court's damage award was rationally based, because it considered the expert's experience and methodology. *See Avery v. Kennebec Millwork, Inc.*, 2004 ME 147, ¶ 3, 861 A.2d 634, 635.
