MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of Dale H. Jr. and Benjamin H. appeals from a judgment entered in the District Court (Farmington, *McElwee*, *J*.) denying her motion for relief from judgment pursuant to M.R. Civ. P. 60(b), in which she sought to vacate an order terminating her parental rights. Contrary to the mother's contentions, the court did not abuse its discretion in denying her motion after finding that (1) the mother presented no new evidence, *see*, *e.g.*, *Estate of McCormick*, 2001 ME 24, ¶ 39, 765 A.2d 552, 565; and (2) she was not under duress when she consented to the termination of her parental rights, but rather acted knowingly, voluntarily, and freely, *see In re Danielle B.*, 685 A.2d 770, 771 (Me. 1996).
