MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Joseph A.F. Sadowski appeals from an order of the Superior Court (Kennebec County, *Studstrup, J.*) denying his motion for enlargement of time in which to file a notice of appeal. Despite Sadowski's contention that he had good cause for his untimely filing of his motion for enlargement, the Superior Court did not err in denying his motion because it was filed more than twenty-one days after the expiration of the original time for filing an appeal. M.R. App. P. 2(b)(5)(A); *see Rice v. Amerling*, 433 A.2d 388, 390-92 (Me. 1981).
