MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Guizhen Feng appeals from a judgment of conviction of theft by unauthorized taking or transfer (Class E), 17-A M.R.S. § 353(1)(A) (2005), entered in District Court (Bangor, *Griffiths, J.*). Pursuant to M.R. App. P. 5(b)(1), it was Feng's responsibility, as a nonindigent appellant, to pay for and provide this Court with a transcript. Her failure to do so leaves us with an inadequate record and makes review of the merits of her arguments impossible. *See State v. Ross*, 1997 ME 67, ¶ 1, 691 A.2d 1253, 1254.
