MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Godbless Asante appeals from a judgment entered in District Court (Springvale, *Janelle, J.*) finding that he committed the traffic violations of speeding, 29-A M.R.S. § 2073(3) (2005), and operating a truck in a restricted lane, 23 M.R.S. § 1980 (2005). The appellant bears the burden of providing this Court with a record that allows adequate consideration of the arguments on appeal. *State v. Hughes*, 2004 ME 141, ¶ 7, 863 A.2d 266, 269. Because Asante has failed to include a transcript, or a statement in lieu of a transcript, in the record of this appeal, we will “assume that the transcript would support the trial court’s findings

of fact and its rulings on evidence and procedure.”” *Id.* ¶ 7, 863 A.2d at 269 (quoting *State v. Nugent*, 2002 ME 111, ¶ 2, 801 A.2d 1001, 1002).
