MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Leavitt Baker appeals from a judgment entered in the District Court (West Bath, *Field, J.*) finding that Baker was not entitled to repayment of funds that he had advanced to Naomi Reno to purchase and operate a cleaning business. Contrary to Baker's contentions, the court did not err in evidentiary rulings excluding pictures allegedly sent to Baker by a witness, and allowing cross-examination about repair work at his home. Furthermore, the record does not compel findings in Baker's favor on his claims for repayment of funds. *See Westleigh v. Conger*, 2000 ME 134, ¶ 12, 755 A.2d 518, 520.
