MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The mother of Joseph and Joshua A. appeals from a judgment entered in the District Court (Skowhegan, *LaVerdiere, J.*) terminating her parental rights as to her sons pursuant to 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2) (2005). Contrary to the mother's contentions, sufficient evidence exists in the record to support the court's findings, by clear and convincing evidence, establishing the grounds for termination, *see id.* § 4055(1)(B)(2)(b)(i), (ii), (iv), and that termination is in the boys' best interests, *see id.* § 4055(1)(B)(2)(a).
