MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Richard Hawksley appeals the judgment of the Superior Court (Hancock County, *Hjelm*, *J*.) finding him liable for compensatory and punitive damages stemming from an incident of civil assault against Maureen Leach. Contrary to his contention, the court did not err when it refused to admit, as irrelevant, his testimony that would have purported to explain why he pleaded guilty to criminal assault. *See* M.R. Evid. 401; *State v. Moon*, 2000 ME 142, ¶7, 755 A.2d 527, 529; *State v. Witham*, 1997 ME 77, ¶ 10, 692 A.2d 930, 934; *see also Glynn v. Atl. Seaboard Corp.*, 1999 ME 53, ¶ 16, 728 A.2d 117, 121. Moreover, Hawksley

testified fully to his version of the events that resulted in the criminal assault charge and this civil lawsuit.
