MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Joseph Thiboutot appeals from a judgment entered in Superior Court (York County, *Brennan, J.*) after a bench trial, which ordered the liquidation of the corporation jointly owned by Thiboutot and Neil L. Weinstein and awarded Weinstein \$58,000 from the sale of the corporation's building. Contrary to Thiboutot's contention, the court did not clearly err when it found that Weinstein was not acting as Thiboutot's attorney with respect to the affairs of the corporation and when it found that Weinstein had expended \$58,000 of his personal funds for the carrying costs of the corporation's building. There was evidence in the record to support these findings, and the weight and meaning given to the conflicting

evidence was for the trial court to determine. *Jenkins, Inc. v. Walsh Bros.*, 2002 ME 168, ¶ 7, 810 A.2d, 929, 933.
