MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Mark Dobbins appeals from a judgment entered in the Superior Court (Penobscot County, *Mead, J.*), affirming a decision of the Maine Unemployment Insurance Commission, which denied unemployment benefits to Dobbins because it found that he had been discharged from his employment for misconduct. Contrary to Dobbins's contentions, there was substantial evidence presented by Dobbins's employer to support the Commission's finding of misconduct, as that term is defined in 26 M.R.S. § 1043(23) (2005); the Commission's procedure was not unlawful; and the Commission's decision was not the product of bias.
