MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Alan P. and John Hess appeal from an order of the Superior Court (Penobscot County, *Hjelm, J.*) granting in part plaintiffs Paul B. Means and Twin City Rodeways, Inc.'s motion for attachment and attachment on trustee process on one count of their five count verified complaint. Means and Rodeways cross-appeal the court's denial of the motion for attachment and attachment on trustee process on the other four counts.

Contrary to the parties' contentions, the court did not commit clear error or abuse its discretion in granting in part and denying in part the motion for

attachment and attachment on trustee process. *See Liberty v. Liberty*, 2001 ME 19, ¶ 11, 769 A.2d 845, 847; M.R. Civ. P. 4A(c), 4B(c).
