MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The parents of Richard P., Christian P., and Joseph P. appeal from judgments of the District Court (Portland, *Goranites, J.*) terminating their parental rights pursuant to 22 M.R.S. § 4055(1)(B)(2)(a), (b)(i), (ii), (iv) (2005). Contrary to the parents' contention, there is sufficient evidence in the record to support the court's findings by clear and convincing evidence of at least one ground of parental unfitness. *See, e.g., In re Alana S.*, 2002 ME 126, ¶ 20, 802 A.2d 976, 981; *In re Justin T.*, 640 A.2d 737, 738-39 (Me. 1994); *In re Ryan L.*, 581 A.2d 811, 812 (Me. 1990). The record also discloses sufficient evidence to support the court's finding by clear and convincing evidence that termination of their parental rights is

in the children's best interest. *See In re Ashley A.*, 679 A.2d 86, 89 (Me. 1996); *In re Justin T.*, 640 A.2d at 739.
