MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

David Boucher appeals from a conviction entered in District Court (Farmington, *McElwee, J.*) for failure to register a vehicle in violation of 29-A M.R.S. § 351(1)(B) (2005) (Class E). Despite Boucher's contentions, the District Court properly exercised jurisdiction over him. Additionally, and contrary to Boucher's contentions, section 351 is not constitutionally infirm, and the court did not err in denying his motion to dismiss. *See Kenny v. Dep't of Human Servs.*, 1999 ME 158, ¶ 7, 740 A.2d 560, 563. Finally, sufficient evidence exists in the

record to support the conviction under section 351. *See State v. Holmes*, 2004 ME 155, ¶ 10, 864 A.2d 166, 168.
