MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The Estate of Bradley Paul Bates Allaire appeals from a summary judgment entered in Superior Court (York County, *Fritzsche, J.*) on its complaint against Jayson Daney for negligently causing the death of Bradley Allaire. Contrary to the Estate's argument, the trial court did not err in granting Daney's motion for summary judgment because the Estate did not present a prima facie case to support proximate cause. *See Houde v. Millett*, 2001 ME 183, ¶ 12, 787 A.2d 757, 759-60; *Crowe v. Shaw*, 2000 ME 136, ¶ 11, 755 A.2d 509, 512-13.
