MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

Thomas A. Davis appeals from a divorce judgment entered in the District Court (Portland, *Beaudoin, J.*) dissolving his marriage to Paula J. Davis. Thomas argues that the trial court abused its discretion (1) by ordering him to pay Paula \$1500 per month in spousal support; (2) in its disposition of marital property; and (3) by awarding Paula \$1500 in attorney fees. Contrary to Thomas's contentions, the court did not abuse its discretion in its award of child support, its disposition of martial property, or its award of attorney fees. *See Urquhart v. Urquhart*,

2004 ME 103, ¶¶ 3, 6, 854 A.2d 193, 194-95; Doucette v. Washburn, 2001 ME 38, ¶ 23, 766 A.2d 578, 586.
