MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The father of Jonathon and Leeanna G. appeals from a judgment entered in York County Probate Court (*Nadeau, J.*) awarding permanent guardianship of the two children to their paternal aunt. The father argues that the Probate Court erred by failing to comply with the requirements of the Uniform Child Custody Jurisdiction and Enforcement Act, 19-A M.R.S. §§ 1731-1783 (2005) and the Parental Kidnapping Prevention Act, 28 U.S.C.S. § 1738A (LexisNexis 2003), by entering an order for custody when jurisdiction was in New Hampshire. In accordance with those laws, the Probate Court properly communicated with the New Hampshire Family Division Court and determined that jurisdiction was in

Maine. In addition, the father has failed to demonstrate that the Probate Court committed any error of law in awarding guardianship of the children to the aunt.
